

**EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**

**1990-06**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 1990-03 BY PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF JET PROPELLED BOATS OR VESSELS WITHIN CERTAIN LAKES IN SOUTH WALTON COUNTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WALTON COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Section 1 of Emergency Ordinance 1990-03 be amended to read as follows:

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a jet ski, Sea Doo, Wave Runner, or any other jet propelled boat or vessel in the Gulf of Mexico within three hundred (300) feet of the mean high water mark along the shore of the Gulf of Mexico nor shall any jet propelled boats or vehicles be operated in Fuller Lake, Bald Hill, Campbell Lake, Lake Oyster, Lake Allen, Big Redfish, Little Redfish, Western Lake, Eastern Lake, Deer Lake, Camp Creek, Alligator Lake, Stalworth, and Draper Lake.

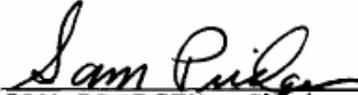
SECTION II. Any person, firm, or corporation who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed 60 days or by both such fine and imprisonment. Nothing contained herein shall prevent or prohibit "access corridors" for such jet propelled boats or vessels above described from entering into the Gulf of Mexico. Such "access corridors" shall be designated by the Board of County Commissioners and or its designated representatives and shall be posted as such. The "access corridors" shall not exceed 50 feet in width.

SECTION III. This ordinance is adopted on an emergency basis and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and when a copy has been filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida.

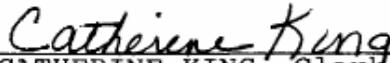
NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that, ordinance 1990-03 be and the same is hereby repealed.
