Questions to Consider

- Has vulnerable infrastructure been identified?
- Are transportation and critical facilities prioritized for repair?
- Are there roads that are susceptible to flooding or surge?
- Are there procedures in place for destroyed bridges?
- Is there a protocol for building and bridge inspection following the disaster?
- How can temporary recovery operations and infrastructure placement be preplanned to benefit capital investment goals?
- Are the identified debris sites viable long-term with proximity to housing, sensitive areas, etc.?
- Have debris plans been approved by FEMA to maximize rates?

- What infrastructure and public facilities are covered under insurance policies and which projects will be eligible for the Public Assistance Program or other grant programs?
- Are there any critical facilities to be mitigated?
- Do any critical facilities need to be relocated?
- Are alternative routes outlined if bridges are out?
- How can infrastructure and public facilities recovery planning be coordinated regionally?
- Are there Sustainable Priority Redevelopment Areas that need new infrastructure service or enhanced capacity to support targeted redevelopment after a major disaster?
