

### Deer Lake Bridge

UNDER CONSTRUCTION: this project involves the relocation of existing utilities, the removal of the existing box culvert, the installation of a new precast concrete bridge, the realignment of the roadway and multiuse path and installation of drainage facilities.

UNDER CONSTRUCTION: construction of a new asphalt roadway segment located south of the intersection of East Point Washington Road and Ivy Lane in Santa Rosa Beach.
