**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
WALTON COUNTY ADOPTING A POST DISASTER
REDEVELOPMENT PLAN (PDRP); AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.**

NOW BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, as follows.

1. Authority; Intent

Walton County is located in an area that is vulnerable to an array of natural and man-made disasters. Pursuant to Objective C-2.4, of the Walton County Comprehensive Plan, Walton County has the authority and is required to maintain a Post Disaster Redevelopment Plan. The purpose of the Post Disaster Redevelopment Plan is to provide Walton County with a single reference for guiding decision-making during the difficult long-term disaster recovery period and to detail the actions that can be taken before and after a disaster occurs to help speed the recovery and redevelopment process. Walton County was awarded grant funds from FEMA through the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management to develop the Post Disaster Redevelopment Plan that complies with County, State, and Federal requirements.

2. Adoption of Plan


The Post Disaster Redevelopment Plan, as approved by the Florida Division of Emergency Management on June 12, 2012, is consistent with Objective C-2.4, of the Walton County Comprehensive Plan. Therefore, the Board hereby adopts the Walton County Post Disaster Redevelopment Plan, as approved by the Florida Division of Emergency Management on June 12, 2012.
